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## AIM for Windows 5.5 Build 98 Release

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### AFW 5.5 Build 98:

The AIM for Windows Build 98 release includes enhancements for the Customer and Lender Tab that maximize the performance time in retrieving records for sites that have large Customer and or Lender Lists. The release also includes AFW 5.5 high priority defect fixes and additional functionality.

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### Customer and Lender Tab Enhancements:

- Extended the drop down field to include the entire address for the Customer/Lender record
- Removed the code from the drop down results for Customers and Lenders. The code populates to the Code field when the party is selected.
- Customer and Lender results are sorted alphabetically by City and grouped by role. For example, all Bank of America's within a specific city with Lender as the role list together provided the customer name is spelled the exact same (case and space sensitive).
- Increased the amount of time allotted to the user to provide the Customer/Lender Code
- Implemented an aim4win.ini setting that is configurable to return results from the Customer/Lender list when a defined amount of characters are inputted by the user. The parameters for this setting can be any number greater than zero.

**The setting can be turned off by entering zero.**

Aim4win.ini setting within the Environment Options section:

CustNameDropLength= 0 or any number greater than 0

### High Priority Defect Fixes:

- Fixed the GetDisplayPayee name issue experienced when the sales and or loan amount was updated in the Order and the file was taken back to the Closing module.
- Corrected the issue where the HUD defaults defined in Closing Setup for HUD Lines 1108, 1201, 1202, and 1204 did not retain in the HUD.
- Fixed the issue where the Agent ID value was dropped when the Title Officer value was cleared from the Order. Updated the logic to clear the Agent ID only when the Underwriter value is cleared and no policies are saved on the file.

- Extended the Associated File Number field in the Order Screen to hold up to 25 characters.
- Added logic to the Lender Tab to clear any values that may bleed from other fields to the Loan Amount, Loan Number, and Mtg. Ins. Case Number fields when no records exist on the File.
- Added a message to inform users that their entire Customer List cannot be retrieved when clicking on the Ellipse within the HUD when their Customer List exceeds 32,687 records. This is an Excel limitation and the HUD uses Excel as its template.
- Updated the logic for the HUD Quick Save Icon to save HUD data back to the AIM server versus the template directory.

**Additional Functionality:**

- Premium Transfer Fee Utility
  - Created a Clear ID Utility Log to track when the Clear ID Utility has been executed. This log will assist in HUD data loss support calls to determine whether the data is missing due to a user ID being cleared when a HUD file is still open, or if the data was lost because it did not save successfully to the AIM server. The log is stored in the DATA directory for the specific database located on the AIM server drive.
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
